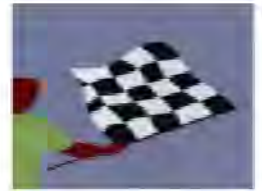
HISTORICAL SOCIETY

AL WHITE'S RACING REPORT

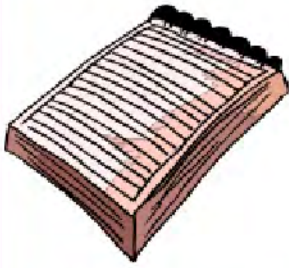
